Beauty for Ashes Flower Garden Mosaic

Materials

- 12 x 12 white cardstock (mosaic platform)
- 3-4 colorful paper (resonate with you)
- Cookie cutters (flower shapes or any inspiring shape)
- Scissors and glue
- Journal for reflections

Steps

Select your paper, which will become your garden's flowers and part of your journey.

Trace and cut flower shapes onto the colored paper. Reflect and write on the back of each flower, expressing your *"pain"* or *"ashes"* (memories, struggles, or feelings to release).

Create your secret garden by sitting with the Father, praying or meditating, focusing on peace and healing.

Apply glue to the ashes, symbolizing the Father sealing your pain.

Arrange the flowers on the cardstock, representing transformation and beauty rising from pain.

Journal your experience, reflecting and connecting with the Father during meditation.

Afterward, share your experience with the group.
