



## Mumball

Materials Needed:

- 5 baking cups
- 1 baking cup of a different color
- Pipe cleaner
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Take the five baking cups and fold each one into quarters.
2. Cut along the ridges of the folded cups.
3. Make a small cut at the tip of each cup, then unfold them.
4. Take a pipe cleaner and thread it through the tiny cut hole of each of the 5 cups.
5. Knot the inside of the pipe cleaner to secure the cups.
6. For the final touch, add another piece of pipe cleaner, applying a little glue to the tip.
7. Press everything together and fill as desired.



## Aster

Materials Needed:

- 5 baking cups
- 1 green baking cup
- 1 mini baking cup
- Pipe cleaner
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Begin with the five baking cups and fold each into quarters.
2. Cut along the ridges and make a small cut at the tip, then unfold.
3. Take the mini baking cup and squish it into one of the baking cups, adding a bit of glue to hold it in place.
4. Repeat this process, fluffing the cups after each step to create volume.
5. Add a pipe cleaner, applying glue to the tip before inserting it.
6. Press everything together and fill as desired.
7. Lastly, add the green baking cup around the pipe cleaner and press it together.



## Lotus

Materials Needed:

- 5 baking cups
- 1 green baking cup
- Pipe cleaner
- Stapler

Instructions:

1. Fold each of the five baking cups into quarters.
2. Cut a slit down the center of the folded cup up to the end of the ridges.
3. Make a diagonal cut on one side, then flip it over to cut the opposite side. This should create a leaf shape.
4. Repeat the cutting on the other side of the center cut to create two leaves.
5. Start with the green cup, unfold it, and carefully assemble the cups, ensuring they don't overlap.
6. Staple the cups together to secure them in place.
7. Thread a pipe cleaner through the holes for added decoration.
8. Fluff the leaves until you achieve your desired look.
